I am pleased to announce that San Francisco Health Plan (SFHP), in collaboration with the University of California San Francisco and Community Health Network (CHN) of San Francisco, is implementing the multilingual SFHP Automated Telephone Self-Management Support (ATSM) program for diabetes in English, Spanish and Cantonese.

During this 6 month program, SFHP patients will receive weekly, interactive telephone calls to help them manage their diabetes. Patients will be asked questions about their diabetes, and their responses will be forwarded to the Nurse Care Managers at SFHP.

Our SFHP Nurse Care Managers will follow-up with any patients who provide out-of-range responses. During the follow-up phone calls, the nurses will:

- Educate members about diabetes.
- Support self-management of diabetes by setting achievable goals.
- Provide motivation and support for patients to adhere to management guidelines and medication regimens that prevent diabetes complications.
- Directly addressing out of range responses from the most recent call.
